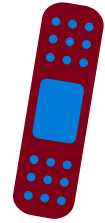




## Jellison Health Center Supply List 2013 Camping Season

All medications should come to camp in their original containers. The camper's name, the name of the medication, the dosage amount and the times to be administered, should all be included on the medication, and on an attached medication form. All medications, prescription and over the counter, need to be turned in to the Extension Agent or Camp Medical Professional upon arrival at camp.

### **Medication DONT'S**

- ⊗ Don't send loose pills in a plastic bag
- ⊗ Don't send pills in a weekly pill organizer.
- ⊗ Don't send Tylenol, Ibuprofen, or other medications listed above.
- ⊗ Don't tell your child it is ok for them to keep their medications with them.
- ⊗ Don't send medications that are not prescribed to your child (ie. in sibling's name)
